Complete Technology Integrations recently completed a comprehensive upgrade and enhancement of the C-Bus Lighting Control at the offices of Macquarie Bank in Sydney.

The two buildings, Bond Street and Martin Place consist of 42 floors and the works included upgrading and rewriting the control system to allow for individual status, control and scheduling of lights in quadrants of each floor.

Cleaners switches have been installed which when activated by the cleaners provide selected light for a short fixed period.
