## CTI Takes Control at National Parks and Wildlife Service

Complete Technology Integrations has recently been awarded the contract to supply and commission the lighting control system in the Hurstville head office for the National Parks and Wildlife Service.



NPWS are located on nine floors and previously used conventional

switching to control lighting which they found to be seldom turned off. To be more environmentally and energy responsible, NPWS replaced and relocated some luminaries to compliment the CTI Control System.

CTI controls existing light circuits, provides local zone lighting control and uses a central processor to perform after hours timing functions.

The systems operation is extremely simple with little or no user training required.
